

Spring Flower Sale



Seed Geranium-if you need to arrange several containers or want to create a beautiful border then seed geraniums are what you need. They are low cost and come in a variety of colors.

Colors- Red, Pink, Quicksilver, Salmon, Violet, White

Flowering Period- Mid May thru September

Height- Grows 12-15 inches

Spacing- 12 inches

How to grow- plant in sun or part shade, widely adaptable to soil.



Begonia - Colors – Dark Leaf: Scarlet, pink, white & mixed – Green Leaf: Scarlet, pink, white & mixed

Flowering period - Mid June to mid October.

Height - Grows 6" to 12" tall (15 - 30 cm).

How to grow - Plant in sun or part sun.

Features - Low growing plants.

Soil - Best in rich, well drained soil.

Spacing - Plant 12" apart (30 cm).

Tips - Keep soil moist, water in morning not mid day. Plants do not

compete well with other annuals, so mass them alone. Use in borders, beds or pots.



Dusty-Miller - Color - Silver

Flowering period - Early May to the end of September.

Height - Grows 6" to 10" tall (15 - 25 cm).

How to grow - Plant in sun or part sun. Features - Silver white leaves.

Soil - Best in light, well drained soil, high in organic matter, but

performs admirably in dry sandy soils. Tolerates drought.

Spacing - Plant 8" apart (20 cm). Tips - Excellent frost tolerance. Very low maintenance plant.

Prune periodically to maintain low, bushy shape. Uses - Use in borders, beds or for contrast.



Impatiens - Colors – Red, pink, white, Rose, pink, orange & Violet.

Flowering period - Mid June to mid October.

Height - Grows 8" to 12" tall (20 - 30 cm). How to grow - Plant in part sun or shade.

Features - Large flowers on compact plants.

Soil - Fertile, sandy soil, rich in organic matter.

Spacing - Plant 15" apart (38 cm).

Tips - Poor frost tolerance. Requires frequent watering. No deadheading

is required. Low maintenance annuals. Avoid hot, dry locations.

Uses - Use in borders, beds or pots.



Marigold - Dwarf: Gold, yellow, orange, Red. – Inca (Giant): Orange, & yellow

Flowering period - to the end of October.

Height - Grows 10" to 12" tall (25 - 30 cm). How to grow - Plant in full sun.

Soil - Best in moist, well drained loam but tolerates dry soils.

Marigolds grow well in poor soil. Spacing - Plant 12" apart (30 cm).

Tips - Moderate frost tolerance. Low maintenance. Performs well in all weather conditions. Pinching out the first central flower bud will produce bushier plants.

Uses - Use in beds, pots or borders.



Petunias - Colors – Red, pink, white, plum, coral, blue

Flowering period - Mid May to mid October. Height - Grows 12" to 15" tall (30 - 38 cm).

How to grow - Plant in sun or part sun.

Features - Bright blend of flowers with blooms all summer long.

Soil - Best in well drained, light sandy soil. Spacing - Plant 12" to 15" apart (30 - 38 cm).

Tips - These plants have excellent weather resilience.

Before you leave for holidays, cut back petunias to half height, water thoroughly and fertilize. They will be bushy and full of new buds and flowers when you return.

Uses - Use in borders, beds and pots.



Salvia - Colors - Red, & Blue

Flowering period - Mid June to the end of October. Height - Varies with variety.
 How to grow - Plant in sun or part sun. Features - Colorful flower spikes.
 Soil - Best in well drained, moist, rich soil high in organic matter. Spacing - Plant 12" apart (30 cm).
 Tips - Moderate to poor frost tolerance.
 Requires more fertilizing than other annuals, in summer months fertilize once a week.
 One of the most uniformly even growing annuals.
 Uses - Use in beds or borders.



Vinca - Colors- Apricot, Rose with eye, Pink, Orchid, White with eye

Flowering period - Early June to the end of September.
 Height - Grows 12" tall (30 cm). How to grow - Plant in full sun.
 Features - Compact bushy plants have showy flower colors.
 Tolerant of summer heat. Soil - Best in well drained soil.
 Spacing - Plant 10" to 15" apart (25 - 38 cm).

Tips - Tolerant of hot and dry conditions. Uses - Use as ground cover or in containers.



Alyssum - Colors - white, purple & mixed

Flowering period - Mid June to the end of September.
 Height - Grows 3" to 5" tall (8 - 13 cm). How to grow - Plant in sun or part sun.
 Features - Mixed flower colors. Spreading plants.
 Soil - Best in well drained soil, but will perform well in poor soils.
 Spacing - Plant 10" apart (25 cm). Tips - Poor frost tolerance. Very fragrant, especially white flowers. Fast growing. Keep evenly moist, but not waterlogged.
 Uses - Use in borders, planters or beds.



Coleus -

Flowering period - Mid June to mid October.
 Height - Grows 10" to 15" tall (25 - 38 cm).
 How to grow - Plant in part sun or shade. Features - Brilliant foliage.
 Soil - Rich, well drained soil, high in organic matter. Tolerates poor dry soil.
 Spacing - Plant 10" apart (25 cm).
 Tips - Poor frost tolerance. Keep soil moist. Too much sun will fade foliage.
 To maintain bright foliage color, remove the tiny lilac flowers as they appear.
 Uses - Use in beds, borders and pots.
