

Asbury Elementary School 2018-2019 School Year Goals

Academics

Through TBT, data meetings and professional development we will increase our math achievement in grades 3-5 on the Ohio State Test by monitoring MAP scores and student progress of mastery for the objective. 3rd grade math scores will increase from 42.6% to 54%, 4th grade will increase from 64.3% to 69% and 5th grade will increase from 34.4% to 46%.

Intention

Through professional development and the work of our TBTs, we will use progress monitoring checklists in all math classes. With the use of our walk through application, we will increase student progress of mastery for the objective taught from 45% last school year to 80% in math classes during the 2018-2019 school year.

Mindset

Through the work of our BLT and PBIS committee, we will focus our morning meetings on social emotional learning by using the Well Managed School Skill of the Week, our Second Step program, and our building wide character traits to reduce the number of days of out of school suspensions from the previous year. We will reduce our total out of school suspension days by 20% (from 170 days to 138 days) during the 2018-2019 school year.

Leadership

We will increase the number of students who score in the basic, proficient, accelerated and advanced categories by 20%. By doing so we will increase our performance index from 76.432 points to 80.769 points resulting in 67.3% D on the achievement component of the AIR test in the 2018-2019 school year.
