Course Description: You will have at least 60% of hands on practice to create Interactive Smart Notebook Classroom Lessons and search for pre-designed Interactive Objects / Lessons / Pages for students and classroom instruction as it relates to the participants Content Standards & Course of Study. The course will train users on the full capabilities of the SmartBoard & Notebook 10/11 tools (focusing on the Interactive/Multimedia Tools) and resources (introductory - advanced). Also, the participants will be able to preview Best Practice Interactive/Multimedia Enriched Smart Notebook Lessons that relate to their specific course / grade level standards. The course will be centered on developing lesson plans and/or pre-designed lesson plans that will be used within the classroom instruction, student useage and to motivate student learning of the content. Throughout the class we will demonstrate how to use their iPad / iPhone, IOS 7, Tablets or other SmartPhone Devices. We will also focus on Web Resources that Participants could use on all mobile devices within their classroom. We will use iMovie (Mac) & Windows Live MovieMaker to edit their videos. Participants that would like to learn on the Macs, will need to bring their own MAC laptop. We will format & convert the videos to be downloaded on SmartPhones, as a Podcast and/or Online. Within the course, we will train participants on the necessary tools how to record & download their own lesson video.

Course Description: This course provides a Hands On approach for learning the essentials of MovieMaker (Windows), IMovie (MAC), Audacity, Page Recorder / Smart Recorder (Smart Notebook Software) and Photo Gallery (free software that is installed on every windows 7 computer). We will also show you how to download video from YouTube and other websites. This course will train you on how integrate these Videos, Audio & Photo files within your IPad/IPhone/ SmartPhone/Tablet, PowerPoint, Smart Notebook Software and other programs. After the creation of the videos we will convert and compress the video files to MP4. Also, we will work with multiple websites that store video files. This course will show you how to convert and embed video code from numerous websites into PowerPoint, Smart Notebook, MovieMaker and IMovie. During the course, you will create your own Video and Photo Gallery that will focus on an appropriate lesson that will assist within your classroom instruction or assigned position. You will present your video project to the class.
