We will decrease our out of school suspension by 20% from the 17-18 school year resulting in less than 129 suspensions. (Baseline: 162 out of school suspensions during the 2017-2018 school year). Intention


We will increase the number of students having satisfactory attendance (above 95%) by 15%, resulting in 64% or higher of students enrolled attending school 95% of the time. Through the work of our PBIS team, we will implement strategies that encourage students and parents to attend school on a regular basis. (Baseline: In 17-18, 48.8 % of students had satisfactory attendance).

Academics

We will increase the percent of students proficient on the ELA AIR Assessment by 10% for the 2018-2019 school year. TBT meetings, professional development, and use of district adopted online programs will all assist in this increase. (Baseline: 3rd grade 42.3%; 4th grade 40.3%; 5th 43.9%)

Leadership

We will increase the number of students who score in the basic, proficient, accelerated and advanced categories by 20%. By doing so we will increase our performance index from 71.109 points to 75.626 points resulting in 63.0% on the achievement component of the AIR test in the 2018-2019 school year.
