Sedalia Elementary School 2018-2019 School Year Goals

Academics

The percentage of K-5 Sedalia students at the 55th percentile or higher will increase from 54% to 64% as measured on MAP ELA from spring 2018 to spring 2019.

Intention

We will increase the use of progress monitoring in math and ELA building-wide as evidenced by McREL walkthrough data. Progress monitoring will increase from 20% to 53.3% and progress toward this goal will be reported to staff monthly.

Mindset

Sedalia Elementary will decrease the total number of out-of-school suspension days for grades K-3 by 35% from the previous school year (2017-2018). Last year's out of school suspension days totaled 138 for grades K-3. A 35% reduction would be a total of 89 K-3 suspension days or less for the 2018-2019 school year.

Leadership

Increase basic, proficient, accelerated and advanced performance levels by 20%, improving the school's Performance Index Score to 96.119 up from 93.117 in the 2017-2018 school year.
