Academics

The percentage of K-5 Sedalia students at the 55th percentile or higher will increase from 54% to 64% as measured on MAP ELA from spring '18 to spring '19.

We will increase the use of progress monitoring in math and ELA building-wide as evidenced by McREL walkthrough data. Progress monitoring will increase from 20% to 53.3% and progress toward this goal will be reported to staff monthly.

Mindset

Sedalia Elementary will decrease the number of students disciplined for disrespectful and disruptive behavior by 30% during the '18-'19 school year. Last year's referrals totaled 130. That total will be decreased by 30% which would be 39 fewer instances per 130 referrals.

Leadership

We will increase the number of students who score in the basic, proficient, accelerated and advanced categories by 20%. By doing so we will increase our performance index from 93.117 points to 96.119 points in the 2018-2019 school year.
