This unique approach enables those with disabilities to become independent bicycle riders. iCan Bike™ is the perfect program for individuals at least 8-years old who want to learn to ride a two-wheel bicycle!

The iCan Bike™ staff will travel to Columbus to implement our camp. These highly trained staff members will be on hand to ensure that campers are using the right bike for their size, strength and ability, are being assisted properly by the volunteers, and are safe.

Each camper will be assigned two volunteer spotters that will walk and run as the camper pedals. Volunteers must be at least 15 years of age and must be physically capable of running to keep up with the bikes.
