

Comparison of the Ocular Surface in Adult and Pediatric Contact Lens Wearers

Purpose

- Researchers at The Ohio State University College of Optometry are conducting a study to better understand why adults may suffer from more contact lens-related dry eye than children by taking measurements of the front part of the eyes.

Who Can Participate

- Current soft contact lens wearers (at least 2 days/week over the last 90 days)
- Ages 7 to 17 years old or 25 to 40 years olds

What Will Happen

- There will be 1 study visit that lasts approximately 90 minutes
- You will be asked to complete questionnaires regarding your contact lens wearing experience
- We will take measurements of the front parts of your eyes
- We will collect a small sample of your tears
