# Child Sexual Abuse Victim Trauma Treatment Groups

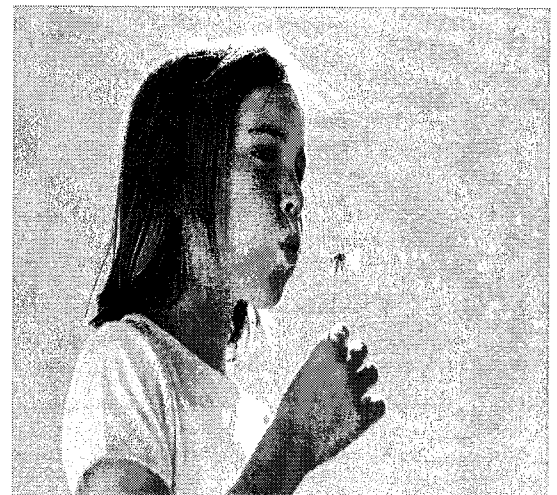

The Family Support Program offers Victim Trauma Treatment groups for child & adolescent sexual abuse victims and their non-offending caregivers. The treatment groups help children learn coping skills, decrease isolation, process sexual abuse issues, and provide support & education to the caregivers. Groups are offered for the following ages:

- Preschool (ages 3 & 4)
- 5-7 year old
- 8-10 year old
- 11-13 year old (separated by gender)
- Teen (ages 14-17—separated by gender)

Non-offending Caregiver groups are offered in a separate room at the same time.

**Groups are held after school and meet once a week for ten weeks. Group sessions are one hour. Snacks are provided.**
