



Exposure to Family Violence Treatment Groups

The Family Support Program at Nationwide Children's offers treatment groups for children and adolescents who have been exposed to family violence. The treatment groups help children and adolescents to express feelings, decrease isolation, learn about safety planning, learn about healthy relationships, and provide support and education to the non-offending caregivers.

Groups are offered to males and females, ages 3-15.



Groups are held after school and meet once a week for eight weeks. Group sessions are one hour and snacks are provided.
