Board Items

Introduction of Facilitator

Mr. Grube introduced Mr. Gary Barber, the volunteer facilitator, and explained that the agenda is fluid intentionally to allow for maximum engagement and collaboration.

Mr. Grube explained that the strategic planning session should help us to be strategic about the District's focus by establishing shared, clear expectations.

Discussion Item - Closing the Execution Gap

Mr. Barber introduced 4DX and illustrated the difference between the whirlwinds and goals. He explained how urgent tasks in our daily job can create a whirlwind that acts upon us. Whereas goals represent important new activities that we act upon.

He shared the following disciplines that can be used to help focus attention, track and measure goals.

Discipline 1: Focus on the WIG (Wildly Important Goal)

Discipline 2: Act on Lead Measures (Lead Measures must be Influenceable and Predictive)

Discussion Item - Norms of Collaboration Attachment

The group worked through an exercise to identify Hopes and Fears

Discussion Item - Financial Strategies Attachment

Mrs. Drummey lead a financial discussion starting with a review of the forecast assumptions to refresh members about the District's current financial status, levy options and methods to reduce projected operating deficits.

She explained the need for an operating levy. She discussed the current levy amount, expiration and next steps for renewal. She explained how millage is calculated and illustrated the impact of mils on a home owner. Mrs. Drummey reviewed six different types of levies sharing the pros and cons of each for Groveport Schools.

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Discussion Item – School Safety

Mr. Smathers suggested that school safety discussion be addressed tomorrow as it naturally leads into discussion about the instruction process and closing the education gap.

Mr. Grube invited the Board to share the feedback they received from meetings with first set of student groups regarding safety.

Mr. Barber facilitated a SWAT exercise on student discipline.

Mr. Smathers shared student discipline data. He discussed the impact of Covid-19, inconsistent discipline coding and Cruiser Academy that make data comparison over time look unusual.

Mr. Smathers indicated that student access to phones and social media impact behaviors in a negative way. He expressed the need to help students develop a peace over pride approach.

The Board and Administrators discussed weapon detection methods, including available tools and technology that would provide early warning.

The Board discussed staffing options that would help promote a safe environment.

Mr. Barber led the Board through TRELLO to illustrate how to capture data and measure progress of safety efforts.
