Continuation of Comments, Announcements and Other Business

- ➤ Mr. Snyder asked that the Board discuss the date of the next Board retreat before it becomes summer. He also wanted to know if information is available on July 4th parade.
- ➤ Mrs. Walsh suggested that perhaps during retreat the Board could visit a school facility out of District as part of the facility planning.
- ➤ Mr. Gray expressed her disappointment in the Board votes on the grading system and wants to know the intention of the Board.
- > Mrs. Dowdell Burger shared that her concern is that case studies do not match the Groveport demographic leaving it unclear how the change would impact minorities.
- ➤ Mrs. Walsh needs more data on methodology and control groups. She also suggested introduction of the change at a slower pace.
- ➤ Mrs. Bok explained that last year teachers were only requesting more time for PD during a difficult year because of Covid-19 and are now in support of the change.
- > Mrs. Gray believes the Board should rely on the experts and educators by trusting their recommendation.
- ➤ Mrs. Walsh objects to the expert cited in the study because he is a convicted felon and misleads clients.
- ➤ Mrs. Dowell-Burger is open to reconsidered in the future with answers to her questions.
- ➤ Mr. Snyder summarized that the Board is not against the grading criteria in concept but needs more information to make an informed decision.
- ➤ Mrs. Ogden explained this is good for students because it gives them more opportunities for success and there really isn't any more information or data available that has not already been presented.
- ➤ Mrs. Walsh suggested that absent other data, consider presenting the Groveport pilot group results.
