Superintendents Agenda

Business Services Update

Chris Reed, Director of Business Services, presented an update on both facility related matters and classified staff.

- The grand opening of Primary One Health Center will be June 15, 2023, while the operational opening will be June 20,2023.
- Work will begin the third week of June on enhancing the safety of three of our school buildings to ensure safer entries—to be completed prior to the first day of school for the 2023-2024 school year.

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- The Cruiser Accel Building has been rezoned and demolition has commenced. This building was purchased with ARP ESSER Funds for \$3,000,000 a significant savings compared to the estimated cost of \$7,000,000 to improve the original site. The renovations at Cruiser Accel will be paid from the General Fund (GF) and will be kept minimal, as the majority of the work will be completed by district maintenance staff.
- Evolv weapon screening units are expected to arrive on June 26, 2023. Groveport Madison administrative staff will complete two days of training on safety protocols and how to use these units effectively. The district is collaborating the OAPSE in regards to their members operating the screen units.
- > Veregy agreement will save approximately \$20,000 annually and \$125,000 over 5 years.
- Ohio School Plan property, liability, and vehicle insurance renewal is slightly increasing over the prior year's cost. This increase is due to the additional vehicles (buses and other district owned vehicles) and the addition of the new building.

Transportation Update

Terry Thomas, Chief Operating Officer of CBS, provided an update on the transportation department. Mr. Thomas shared that there are plans to hire thirty new employees over the Summer. He stated that the fleet operations have been running smoothly. Notably, safety incidents and call reports decreased in the month of May. The year concluded with a fantastic staff picnic, and an ice cream social is scheduled to kick off the new year. Mr. Thomas extended his gratitude to the entire board for their support.

Human Resources Update Attachment

Assistant Superintendent, Paul Smathers, delivered an update on behalf of Director of Human Resources, Matt Cygnor.

- > There ae twelve unfilled vacancies in the district. Five of the vacancies currently have employment offers pending to qualified applicants.
- The Enrollment Department has officially begun their busy season. Since June 1, 2023, 80 students have been enrolled.
