Groveport Madison Schools Cheer Competition Team

The Groveport Madison Cheer Competition Team achieved remarkable accomplishments this year, including being crowned Division Champions at the Buckeye Nationals, March Madness, and Sheridan Spirit competitions. - Board members expressed appreciation for the committee's work. Libby Gray volunteered to join the committee, and her participation was welcomed.

➤ Board President Dowdell-Burger provided updates on two committee meetings: a meet and greet and a session during Cruiser Time to minimize student instruction disruption. The project's focus includes peer mentoring and strengthening student-teacher relationships. It was proposed to include the two non-senior members in next year's committee due to their significant contribution to framework development. Seth Bower highlighted the committee's eleven members, while Jamie Grube mentioned an upcoming meeting. The student group is highly dedicated and represents diverse backgrounds. Seth Bower emphasized the importance of fostering school spirit, improving staff-student relationships, and learning Robert's Rules of Order.
