Review Feedback Worksheets

Is anything missing, misrepresented, or incomplete?



Group #1 (Rachel, Emily, Mitzi, and Darren)

Preference: 3 Pre-K Buildings

- Location & travel time keeping kids close to home
- Fewer transitions
- All services at each building (ESL, gifted, OT/PT, social workers, etc.)
- Small cost difference
- Having three identical buildings would be efficient
- Is anything missing, misrepresented, or incomplete?



Group #2 (Libby, Debra, Todd, Barry)

Preference: (3) Pre-K – 6 Buildings; (1) 7 – 8 Building

- Want both a gym and auxiliary gym
- Cost difference is negligible
- Sixth graders can mentor younger students in the younger grades
- Other comments:
 - Split K-4 & 5-6 into separate buildings
 - Construct 7-8 first



Group #3 (Zachary, Todd, Alcian, Mary, Bob)

Preference: (3) Pre-K – 6 Buildings; (1) 7-8 Building

- Least expensive
- Like size of student bodies for each building



Group #4 (Kim, Roniann, Christopher, James, and Seth)

Preference: (3) Pre-K – 6 Buildings; (1) 7-8 Building

- Liked cost in relation to sports facilities
- Appropriate size for a middle school
- Availability of special services
- Room for future growth
- Other comments:
 - Configure the elementary into a split building Pre-K-3 and 4-6



Group #5 (Gail, Tricia, Shannon, and Ken)

Preference: (3) Pre-K - 6 Buildings; (1) 7 – 8 Building

- Reasonably priced
- Better than the 6-8 due to size (6-8 too large)
- Only have to pay for one sports facility
- Other comments:
 - Break the elementary into two buildings with two wings each



Group #6 (Joy & Ed)

Preference: (3) Pre-K – 5 Buildings; (1) 6 – 8 Building

- Need the 6-8 to get the larger building for athletic facilities
- Streamlined programming
- Few transitions
- Other comments:
 - Design so that building can be expanded with a second floor
