
# Principal's Message

#### Focus on Learning

Mrs. Jahn's 1st-grade class has been focusing on personal narrative writing. They are working on finding small moments that they can tell and write about. Students are focusing on making sure their stories have a beginning, middle, and end. As seen in the pictures, students are working to accomplish this goal with interactive writing. In interactive writing they are also working on capitalization, punctuation, letter formation and forming sentences with a message together. There is even a chance for students to read their writing back and practice their fluency skills! 
