As always, we appreciate your support and your help at home.

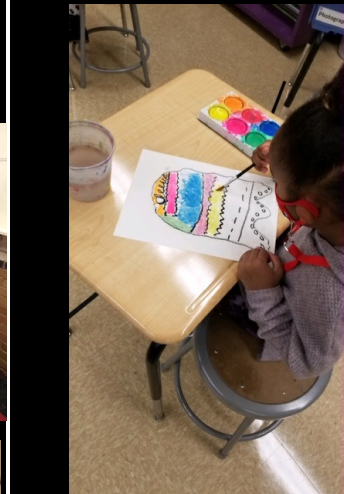
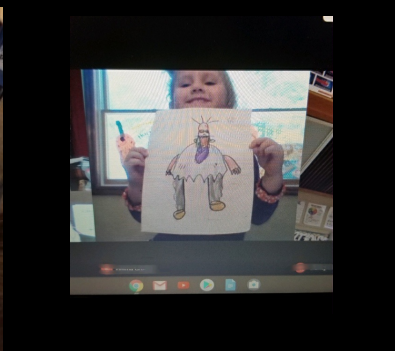
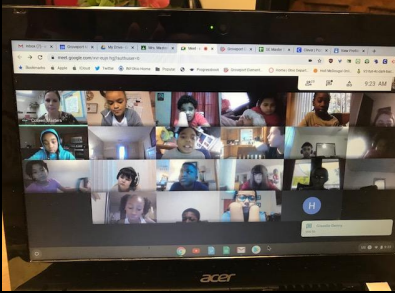
