### **Additional Details on Chromebook Pickup Grades 1-5**

- Super important to come during your assigned time so you can meet your child's teacher.
  - If you cannot come during the assigned grade level time, you may come during any of the pick up times, but your student's teacher may not be available.
- ALL STUDENTS, INCLUDING CRUISER DIGITAL ACADEMY STUDENTS, should follow the schedule above.
- All families must stay in their car.
- Drive through the front loop. A staff member will greet you.
- Families with students in multiple grade levels may pick one time to pick up all chromebooks.
- Along with chromebooks, your student will receive a Welcome Bag with resources and supplies to they will need. We are trying our best to supply students with what they will need, but we may have to have a 2nd pick up of curriculum materials at a later date depending on how long we will be online. Also, teachers might ask for minimal supplies but at this point there is no supply list. When we return to school we might need supplies then and will communicate that to you. at that time.
- You will NOT be allowed to take home a chromebook unless you have completed Final Forms.



If you have a new kindergarten student you should have received a welcome letter with your scheduled appointment date and time. Please arrive on time and park in the back parking lot by the modules. You and your child will both need to wear a mask and we will greet you at the back entrance. Once we have signed your child in for the assessments, you will receive the chromebook and supplies and then you can wait in the parking lot until the assessment is over. The assessment will last about an hour and half. If you have any questions or will not be able to attend your schedule time, please give us a call at school. It is going to be a great year!


