

Currently, we only have about 30 students who still need to complete the chromebook agreement form. That form is on Final Forms and if you don't know how to do it, please call the school we can help. I've listed a glossary of terms below to help with some of the new things we are describing this year. We are looking forward to a fantastic year!

Glossary - to help all of us know what we are talking about :))

Traditional Option - if you picked this option your child will either learn all online, blended, or come 5 days a week. As of now, your child will be all online starting Sept. 8th.

Remote Learning/Virtual Learning/Online Learning - we are using these terms interchangeably to mean your child is at home learning on the computer.

Blended/Hybrid - we are using these terms interchangeably to mean your child will come to school two days a week and will learn from home 3 days a week.

A/B Schedule - The "A" schedule students will attend school on Monday/Tuesday and "B" students will come on Thursday/Friday. If you didn't make prior arrangements then students with last name A - J were assigned the "A" schedule and students with last name K-Z were assigned the "B" schedule.

CDA - stands for Cruiser Digital Academy and these students remain learning from home all year.

Final Forms - new online system all parents use to complete necessary school paperwork.

Chromebook User Agreement - form parents need to sign online so they can take a school chromebook home.

Responsible Restart 2020 Family Guide - information for parents about a safe restart and it is on the website or on Final Forms.

I will share more tech terms with families as students work online. You will receive a direction sheet for logging on to the chromebook and navigating google classroom.

Grades 1-5 Chromebook Distribution Schedule:

<u>Monday, August 31st</u> 1st Grade 9:00-11:30 am 2nd Grade 12:00-2:00 pm

<u>Tuesday, September 1st</u> 3rd Grade 9:00-11:30 am 4th Grade 12:00-2:00 pm

Wednesday, September 2nd 5th Grade 9:00-11:30 am

<u>Thursday, September 3rd</u> Open Time for any grade: 4:00-7:00 pm

<u>Friday, September 4th</u> Open Time for any grade: 9:00-11:30 am

Additional Details on Chromebook Pickup Grades 1-5

- Super important to come during your assigned time so you can meet your child's teacher.
 - If you cannot come during the assigned grade level time, you may come during any of the pick up times, but your student's teacher may not be available.
- ALL STUDENTS, INCLUDING CRUISER DIGITAL ACADEMY STUDENTS, should follow the schedule above.
- All families must stay in their car.
- Drive through the front loop. A staff member will greet you.
- Families with students in multiple grade levels may pick one time to pick up all chromebooks.
- Along with chromebooks, your student will receive a Welcome Bag with resources and supplies to they will need. We are trying our best to supply students with what they will need, but we may have to have a 2nd pick up of curriculum materials at a later date depending on how long we will be online. Also, teachers might ask for minimal supplies but at this point there is no supply list. When we return to school we might need supplies then and will communicate that to you. at that time.
- You will NOT be allowed to take home a chromebook unless you have completed **Final Forms.**


