Glossary - to help all of us know what we are talking about :))

Traditional Option - if you picked this option your child will either learn all online, blended, or come 5 days a week. As of now, your child will be all online starting Sept. 8th.

Remote Learning/Virtual Learning/Online Learning - we are using these terms interchangeably to mean your child is at home learning on the computer.

Blended/Hybrid - we are using these terms interchangeably to mean your child will come to school two days a week and will learn from home 3 days a week.

A/B Schedule - The "A" schedule students will attend school on Monday/Tuesday and "B" students will come on Thursday/Friday. If you didn't make prior arrangements then students with last name A - J were assigned the "A" schedule and students with last name K-Z were assigned the "B" schedule.

CDA - stands for Cruiser Digital Academy and these students remain learning from home all year.

Final Forms - new online system all parents use to complete necessary school paperwork.

Chromebook User Agreement - form parents need to sign online so they can take a school chromebook home.

Responsible Restart 2020 Family Guide - information for parents about a safe restart and it is on the website or on Final Forms.

I will share more tech terms with families as students work online. You will receive a direction sheet for logging on to the chromebook and navigating google classroom.




Tehya Weeks and Jaelyn Coleman!
