Recommendations for Comprehensive School Safety Plan

Consideration for safety staffing:

- 1. Social Workers Currently 4, requesting 4 additional (2 HS, 1 at each MS, 3 ES)
- Safety and Security Staff Current have 5 HS & 1 at each MS, requesting 5 additional. Help with Weapon Detectors and move to provide support in the elementary schools.
- 3. School Resource Officers Currently 2 (1 North MT & 1 South Groveport), request 1 more Groveport SRO and Madison Township SRO
- 4. School Nurse (We need a School Nurse in every school fulltime) Currently 6, requesting 5 additional.
- 5. Administrator overseeing all Student and Family Engagement, Diversity, Code RRED District Committee, School Safety CPI, Traumatic Crisis Intervention Team, Threat Assessment, Crisis Response, De-Escalation training.
- 6. Coordinator for Social, Emotional and Mental Health Services, MTSS, PBIS, RTI, SEL, supervises Social Workers, Nurses, Social Service programming.
