

Groveport Madison Grab & Go Meal Plans

Our food services department will provide a Grab & Go-style bagged meal consisting of both lunch and breakfast items (breakfast for the next morning). Meal service will run from 11:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m., M-F. Meals are available to all children age 18 and under - at no cost. Grab & Go meal service will be provided at the following locations:

To better serve students who aren't within easy walking distance of the above-listed schools, we also will have a mobile Grab & Go meal service. 
