#### Grab and Go Lunch

Our school district has teamed up with Groveport Madison Human Needs to provide meals to area children through at least **June 30**.

Beginning on Wednesday, June 10 Monday and Wednesday 11:30 - 12:30 p.m.

Each Monday, students will get two days of breakfast and lunch, and on Wednesdays, students will get three days of breakfast and lunch. The meals are paid for by the Federal School Lunch Program, which requires distribution sites to give the meals only to children 18 and under. We are awaiting additional information from the Ohio Department of Education regarding meal service beyond June 30. We will keep you informed of any new information as it becomes available.
