



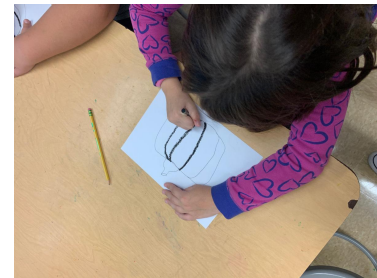
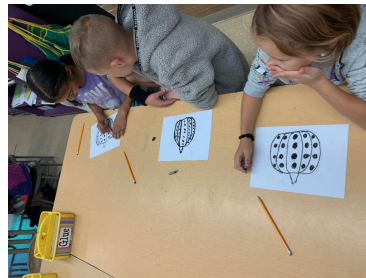
## Principal's Message

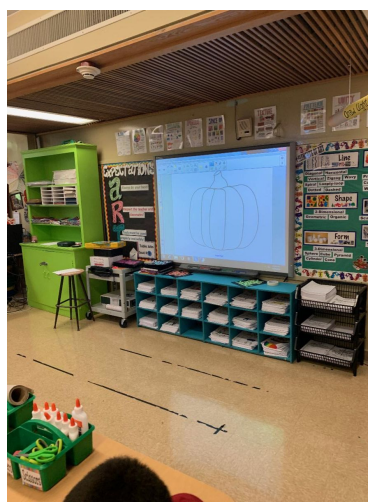
### Interim Reports Go Home Today!

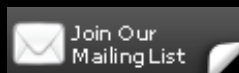
