GM Schools' ZERO Increase in Taxes 5-Year Operating Levy

An operating levy generates funds for the day-to-day operations of the school district - staffing, technology, utilities, supplies, safety and security. With the passage of the levy the District can maintain current operations, including staff levels, programs, activities and opportunities for kids. Without it, the District loses \$2.8 million in the first six months and \$5.6 million a year later. The District would have to make significant cuts. It is ISSUE 7 on your November 5 ballot.





Focus on Learning

This week in Mrs. Stoever's 2nd-grade class, students focused on making a ten to add within 20 (2.OA.2). In 1st-grade, students used 10 sticks and quick ten drawings when making ten. Now in grade 2, the objective is to work at the numerical level as soon as possible and build number sense. The class modeled 9 + 4 by a quick drawing (9 circles) and 4 Xs. Then, students circled one of the Xs to make a group of 10 and quickly could see the relation (9 + 4 or 10 + 3 = 13). Making 10 allows students to work from a friendly number and helps improve their math fact fluency. Students then put their learning to work by solving real-life word problems using this strategy. Students were learning in a variety of ways including whole-group, small group, and individual work.

Fluency with math facts are a crucial skill for 2nd graders to master as they head into 3rd grade and begin learning multiplication and division. Keep up the hard work, 2nd-grade!
