The library also offers Homework Help every day after school - all subjects! 30 Homework Help sessions have been with Groveport Elementary students (mostly 3rd and 5th graders) since mid September. Let's see if we can double that number by March! We aren't assigning a lot of homework - mostly reading and math practice, so if your teacher assigns homework it is important for your learning!

Homework Help Sessions Monday - Thursday 4 -7 and Friday 3 -6

This winter the Homework Help Center we will kick off a new reading program called the Winter Reading Challenge. Students who sign into the Homework Help Center can also sign up for the WRC that will run Dec 3-Feb 28. The intent is to keep students reading in the winter and further develop connections to and attendance in our Homework Help Centers. Students will receive a mechanical pencil and bookmark at sign up and can win a new book after they read 6 hours. (Check out these books!) Students will be tracking the time they spend reading in the Homework Help Center. They can also win a
