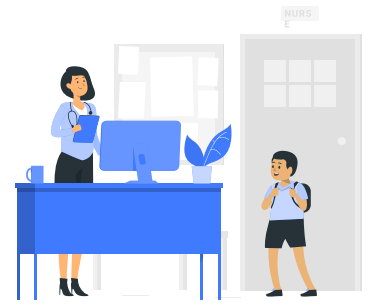


SchoolCare Coordination Program

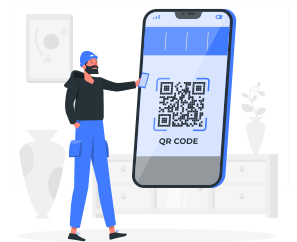


What is Care Coordination?
