
Another Great Week at Groveport Elementary!

Focus on Learning


Every classroom this year begins their day with a "Morning Meeting." These meetings are a positive way to start each child's day and also integrates our STEP 2 counseling program, which focuses on developing social skills and emotional needs of children. The meetings usually begin with a greeting. This teaches students how to properly greet and introduce themselves to another person. Today, in Mrs. Adam's & Mrs. Geisler's room, students used their best robot voice to greet one another. Following the greeting, students will be able to share about an experience, opinion or feeling. This allows students to get to know each other and learn something new about their peers. Students in Mrs. KC's room shared about their favorite snack, Mrs. Myer's students shared their favorite TV show, and Mrs. Monhollen's students had to decide if they would rather eat a bug or a frog! Ewww!! Next is a group activity. Beginning in October, students will be introduced a new social or emotional skill, and our school counselor, Mrs. Winhoven, will be a part of each classroom's meetings. Currently, students are focusing on how to be a Crusar STAR (staying safe, taking responsibility, acting respectfully and reaching goals). Mrs. McGonigal shares a book daily with her students to introduce these skills, as well as reading strategies. Today she read, My teacher is a Monster! Students were asked to focus on making inferences as she read and what the author was trying to relay by writing words in a particular way. The meetings usually close by the teacher going over the schedule, including homework, standards that will be learned, and any changes, such as an assembly. Many teachers and students have already shared how much they are enjoying this time!



Please have conversations with your child(ren) about morning meetings. Practice greeting them when they come home from school and you can even have a basket of questions to ask daily to one another!


