PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

3rd Grade ELA State Testing - TESTING STARTS NEXT WEEK - PLEASE HELP! All 3rd grade students will be taking the English Language Arts Part 1 test on Monday and English Language Arts Part 2 test on Tuesday. It is very important for your child to do their best on the test. Here are a few things you can do to help them.

1. Keep a positive attitude about tests.
2. Mark test days on your calendar so you can give your child a pep talk that morning!
3. Make sure your child gets enough sleep the night before the test.
4. Make sure your child gets up early enough so that he/she will be on time to school and won't feel rushed.

Most important assessment for third graders because they must get a promotion score to be go to 4th grade.
