## Focus on Learning

i-Ready Personalized Instruction **provides students with lessons based on their individual skill level and needs**, so your child can learn at a pace that is just right for them. These lessons are fun and interactive to keep your student engaged as they learn. The goal is for students to spend 45 minutes/week working on lessons in Reading and Math (called time on task) and pass lessons with 70%- 100% accuracy. Our kids are doing a terrific job passing lessons. We need to work a little more on time on task. We are going to be having a class and grade level competition starting October 3rd (Lucky Ducky Competition) to help encourage kids to reach their goals!
