i-Ready Testing - Students have been putting forth a lot of effort on the mid-year diagnostic assessment to show us what they have learned. We are currently at 75% completion for Reading and 79% completion for Math. The testing window closes next Friday and you will receive your child's score report along with a letter explaining the results.
