May 3/4 = Math Part 1 and 2

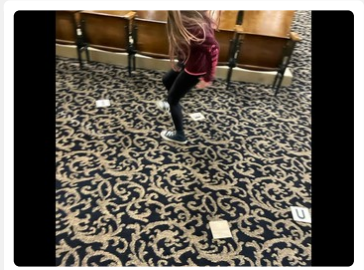
5th Grade
